## **The Bible’s Greatest Comebacks**

### **1. God’s \_\_\_\_\_ Will Be \_\_\_\_\_ (v. 2-3)**

*“Tell the people to march toward Pi Hahiroth between Migdol and the sea. Camp there along the shore, opposite Baalzephon. Then Pharaoh will think, “Those Israelites are confused. They are trapped between the wilderness and the seas.” (v. 2-3)*

### **2. Facing \_\_\_\_\_ Will Be \_\_\_\_\_ (v. 9)**

*“The Egyptians –all Pharaoh’s horses and chariots, horseman and troops pursued the Israelites and overtook them as they camped at the sea.” (v. 9)*

### **3. Prolonged \_\_\_\_\_ Will Be \_\_\_\_\_ (v. 17-18)**

*“It so happened that after Pharaoh released the people, God didn’t lead them by the road through the land of the Philistines, which was the shortest route, for God thought, ‘If the people encounter war, they’ll change their minds and go back to Egypt.’ So God led the people on the wilderness road, looping around the Red Sea. The Israelites left Egypt in military formation.” (v. 17-18)*

### **4. Standing \_\_\_\_\_ Will Be \_\_\_\_\_ (v. 21-22)**

*“Then Moses stretched out His hand over the sea. The waters divided, and the Israelites went through the sea on dry ground, with a wall of water on their right and on their left.” (v. 21-22)*

### **5. Divine \_\_\_\_\_ Will Be \_\_\_\_\_ (v. 27b-28)**

*“The Egyptians were fleeing toward it, and the Lord swept them into the sea. The water flowed back and covered the chariots and horsemen-the entire army of Pharaoh that had followed the Israelites into the sea. Not one of them survived.” (v. 27b-28)*
