

## FAFC Questions and Interaction

1. What was most important lesson for you in the message?
2. The story of the Red Sea parting is one of the most famous stories in the Bible. The message of the story is that God will allow us to face impossible situations but is able to bring a miracle. Describe why it was impossible for Israel. Can you think of a time where something seemed impossible for you? Did you find God's help in the situation?
3. Part of the story is that the enemy tried to destroy them. Like Pharaoh, we have a real enemy (the deceiver) who wants our demise. Talk about a way that he tried to harm or destroy your life in the past. How did God keep that from happening? Why was this important for the Israelites to experience as a new nation? Why was it important for you?
4. God led Israel through an unusual pathway rather than a direct route. Sometimes God will take our lives on a different course than we expected. Have you ever found that this has happened to you? What detour have you been on in the past? Why does it say He did that? Did God have a plan for Israel in it? Did God have a plan for you in it? How was God glorified?
5. The One who is for you is great than the one who is against you. Read 1 John 4:4. Why is that important to hear? The Israelites walked through the Red Sea but the water drowned Pharaoh's army. How does that apply to our lives? If we follow God's guidance, we will find victory. What hope do you find in the story for your life? What is He speaking to you right now?
