1. What stood out in the message to you?
2. Proverbs 3:5,6 says, "Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding." Why is trust a hard characteristic to live out today? Names some instances where our trust has been violated. (Politics, relationships, etc.) Why is it important for one violation not to stop trust in other places? (Name some instances where we have violated trust for others)
3. 2 Corinthian 5:7 says, "We walk by faith, not by sight." While God reveals Himself in many situations, He is often quiet. How can those times of silence strengthen our faith? Talk about a time in your life where you faced a struggle in trusting God. What about the situation that caused it? Did you question Him? How did you reestablish your trust?.
4. In Genesis 22, Abraham finally received his long-awaited son. What did God ask Him to do? Does that make sense to you? What was God teaching Abraham in that time of testing? Has God ever asked you to wait on an answer or trust Him when things went a different direction than you thought they should go? How did you respond?
5. How did Abraham respond? What was God's answer to Him? True or false: God will put me in places where I don't know what He is doing and ask me to trust Him? Talk about how you can prepare for the next time that happens. What can we learn from the past? Ask for His help today.
