1. What was most important to you in the message?
2. In the story of Lazarus, describe the problem that Mary and Martha faced. When they called on Jesus for help, what did He do? Have there been times you have called on Jesus and you felt the same way? What was Jesus' plan in it?
3. Talk about one of these three areas that you have faced (A delay, a doubt, or a discouragement). What is your typical response when you face these areas? Do you tend to try to control it or invite God to control it? Why do we have trouble waiting?
4. Jesus came on the scene and spoke to Martha and Mary. How did they respond the same? How did they respond differently? He gave a bold answer to one and cried with the other. What does this say about what we need to hear and know in a difficult time?
5. In the end, Jesus resurrected Lazarus. Jesus reminds us that He is the resurrecter. What kinds of resurrections does Jesus offer? (Dreams, hurts, healings, emotional pain, hearts, etc.). Name an area that you need Jesus to resurrect? Do you believe that He is able?
